

Borås to Host the 2029 European Disc Golf Championships

The European Disc Golf Federation (EDGF) has selected Borås, Sweden, as the host city for the 2029 European Disc Golf Championships (EDGC). The championship will be held at Ymergårdens Discgolfcenter and will bring together Europe's top senior and junior players as they represent their countries in the pursuit of European titles.

The successful bid is the result of a close collaboration between IK Ymer Frisbee, the City of Borås, and the Swedish Disc Golf Federation. The decision recognizes the long-term commitment to developing Ymergårdens Discgolfcenter and establishing Borås as one of Europe's leading destinations for international disc golf events.

"Sweden has enjoyed great success at the European Disc Golf Championships over the years, and the ambition to once again bring the event to Swedish soil has only grown stronger. Joining the European Disc Golf Federation marked the beginning of that journey, and securing the 2029 Championships is a milestone we are incredibly proud of.
